

AGM-28A Hound Dog

The AGM-28A (Air to Ground Missile) *Hound Dog* appeared in pairs under the wings of the mighty B-52 *Stratofortress* bomber. This missile carried a four megaton warhead, had a delta wing configuration, and came with a J52 rocket engine. The missile could travel in excess of Mach 2 for 350 miles when launched at over 55,000 feet. The missile could supplement the B-52s regular engines in flight; unfortunately, carrying the two missiles on the external pylons somewhat degraded the B-52's flight performance. The *Hound Dog* saw service from 1962 to 1975. Our missile needs to be cleaned, painted, and marked before it can be displayed. The lead-based paint used on the trailer provides an additional challenge to the restoration project.
