Captain Matthew A. Barroner is Chief of Military Justice for the 28th Bomb Wing, Office of the Staff Judge Advocate, Ellsworth Air Force Base, South Dakota – the largest B-1 combat wing in the U.S. Air Force. In addition to advising the Wing and subordinate commanders regarding military justice matters, Capt Barroner assists in delivering comprehensive legal services to more than 3,800 military, civilians, and retirees.



Captain Barroner graduated from Florida State University with a Bachelor of Science in Political Science. He graduated from Syracuse University College of Law in May 2021, earning his Juris Doctorate. He is a member of the New York State Bar and admitted to practice law before the New York Court of Appeals, the United States Air Force Court of Criminal Appeals, and the United States Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces. Captain Barroner received a Direct Commission as an Air Force Judge Advocate and entered active duty in April 2022.
