



## Colonel Paul I. Koecher



Col. Paul I. Koecher is the commander of the 28th Mission Support Group, Ellsworth Air Force Base, SD. He leads a group of six squadrons with nearly 2,000 military, civilian, and contractor professionals in planning, organizing, and implementing installation security and services across the support continuum from contracting, communications, and engineering to logistics and personnel for the combat mission assurance to power the largest operational B-1 wing in the U.S. Air Force -- serving over 8,500 personnel and their families. He is also responsible for coordinating with key mission partners in the surrounding community and serves as an associate school board member representing military families with school-aged children as part of the Air Force School Liaison Program. Prior to taking command, Col. Koecher served as the Chief of the Weather Strategic Plans and Integration Division at Headquarters U.S. Air Force in the Pentagon, Arlington, Virginia.
